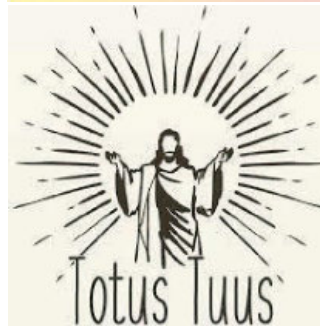

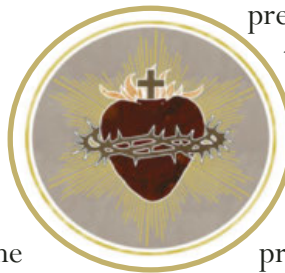

### Corpus Christi and the Sacred Heart

Today we celebrate The Body and Blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ, *Corpus Christi*. Our belief in the true Presence of God in the Eucharist is one of the tenants of our Catholic faith, however in recent years there has been a growing number who, for whatever reason, simply don't believe. Last week, I mentioned that belief need not be wholly understood, but breathed, lived, and in that, will grow to love. How can the bread be *Him*? How can the wine be *His Blood*? I don't know how, but Jesus Himself said that it *can*. He sends His Spirit to and through the priest at the consecration so that we may do this in memory of Him. In memory of covenant, mission, sacrifice, and life, of course, but most of all in memory of the love He bears us. Love of the Divine, through His very humanity, "In His Eucharistic presence he remains mysteriously present in our midst as the one who loved us and gave himself up for us, and he remains under signs that express and communicate this love..." CCC1380 *He remains with us.* Keeping constant vigil... *for us.* He comes down from heaven to meet us in our lowliness and shadows" as Aquinas' hymn goes. St John Chrysostom reminds us "...when you see the priest standing and praying over the victim, and all the worshipers empurpled with that precious blood, can you then think that you are sill among men, and standing upon the earth? Are you not, on the contrary, immediately translated to heaven?" Lost in wonder, indeed! Heaven meets earth! We form a procession Sunday, following His Eucharistic Presence, because we want to follow Him. "Let us follow Him into this holy abode [of His loveable Heart]. May the Heart always live in our hearts!" cries St. Francis de Sales. Our week closes with devotion to His pierced Heart. Our Lord told St Margaret Mary to "Behold this Heart which has so loved man." It is pierced both because of our sins and because it provides an entry point for us to enter in. *Verbum caro factum est* is written on our sanctuary to call to mind this very reality at every Mass. His Heart is present, inviting us to come to Him. Let us follow; let us adore. *Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us!*
