All comments were very positive with no changes requested. Phyllis reported that she met with Father and with the new church cleaning setup he would like the Altar Society ladies to oil the pews 2 times a year, clean the windows/light fixtures, stations and Altars. He has also asked that we recruit 2 (or more) ladies to clean albs and altar clothes weekly. They would need to be trained to do that correctly. He would also like someone to take care of the Holy Water fonts, cleaning and filling. It was discussed that we should put a request in the bulletin.


